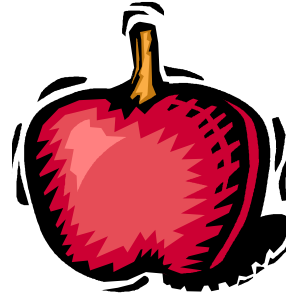

PARENT HANDBOOK REVIEW...

You will be receiving your Parent Handbook at our parent meeting. You will find our written policies on Emergencies, Weather Closures, Illnesses, Lunch Sign-up, Hours of Business, Tuition Payments and most importantly, Arrival/Dismissal Procedures. Remember that written authorization is required for pick up by anyone other than those listed on your child's enrollment package. Please be understanding when we hold your child at school because we have not received written authorization to release them. It is for their safety that we have this policy! Take a minute to add or change any friends or relatives that may be helping with transporting your child to and from school.

SNACK TIME...

We will be asking for your participation in providing the children healthy snacks. A calendar will be printed and distributed on a monthly basis. Your child's name will appear on the calendar indicating your day to bring snack and what to bring to school. Please bring enough for your child's class. If your child has a food allergy, a medical condition and/or there is a concern about snacks being provided at school, parents are responsible for providing their child's snack on a daily basis. Please remember we have a "no nuts" policy. Please check the labels before you send a snack into school.

MONTHLY NEWS & WEEKLY NEWS...

Each month you will receive a newsletter home with your child. This is our way of communicating to you important happenings at school as well as upcoming dates, snack calendars, lunch sign-up reminders, curriculum information and other important things. You should receive a newsletter by the 1st of each month. Please call the office if yours does not make it home.
