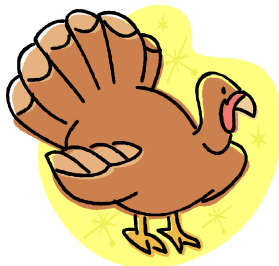
COMPOSTING AT SLC:
